Bugatti: Reaching for Perfection

The Eastern Shore Region's March meeting will be a trip to the Academy Art Museum, 106 South St, Easton. (Southeast corner of South and Harrison Streets.) We will be touring the Museum's exhibit "Bugatti: Reaching for Perfection". From the museum's website:

"Featuring loans from two important private family collections never before seen together, along with pieces from the Museum of Fine Arts, Houston, and the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts, this bijoux exhibition of cars, sculpture, and furniture will illuminate the multigenerational ambition and creativity of the Bugatti. Among the highlights are eight bronze sculptures from the Arsidi-Scuderi Collection of Lugano, Switzerland, and five rare Bugatti cars from an Eastern Shore collection: two grand prix race cars, two Type 57 touring cars, and a miniature "Baby.""

You may drive individually or make your own car pool plans. We will gather at the museum at 10:00 AM on Saturday, March 15th. Parking for people driving classic cars will be in a lot at the northwest corner of S. Harrison and South Streets diagonally across the street from the museum. If you are driving "modern" please save those spots for the antiques. The museum does not have its own lot, but there is street parking and free parking in the lot behind the Waterfowl Festival Building (the old armory). Access to this lot is from Harrison Street via Short Lane. **ACCESS TO THE ART MUSEUM ITSELF IS THROUGH THE COURTYARD ON THE BACK SIDE OF THE BUILDING – EASIEST ENTRANCE TO THE COURTYARD IS FROM THE HARRISON STREET SIDEWALK.**

After our visit to the museum exhibit we will walk or drive 3 blocks to Doc's Downtown Grill on N. Washington Street. They have a "single check policy" so we will be ordering from a fixed price menu with several delicious options developed especially for us. The club will pay the restaurant. Individuals will pay the ESR as noted below.

Cost is \$30 per person, payable to the club on the 15th. This includes a donation to the museum and lunch with beverage, tax, and tip. An "on your own" ice cream shop visit will round out the day.
