After a short business meeting, we will host a **Table Top Car Show**, with People's Choice Award. Show Rules are as follows:

1. Entry Fee \$5. (Entry fee helps to cover the cost of the prize award!)
2. Models will be displayed on top of their entry card which will be put on the display tabletop.
3. Each participant will have **One Minute** to tell the club their model's history and why it's their favorite. * Time limit will be strictly enforced in to give each participant an equal chance to tell their model story.
4. Model dimensions: Maximum length 24" Maximum width 12". Maximum height 12". The models themselves can be old, new and copies of vehicles of any age. Anything goes as long as it fits the size and is automotive related. (i.e. Matchbox, Tonka truck, Pinewood Derby, Revell model kit, Remote control, Dealer Promo, etc.)
5. Models can be made of any material (wood, steel, plastic, tin, carbon fiber, etc.) Model can be handmade or factory manufactured.
6. All entries have to be automotive related? i.e.: Car, Truck, Motorcycle (No model trains, airplanes, etc. accepted.)
7. One entry per person and one vote per person.
8. The Model's owner is the only person who can touch or handle their entry.
9. Anonymous paper vote. *In the event of a tie vote, the Club President will cast the tie breaking vote. One prize will be awarded to the most popular model. This is not a judged show. It's all about having fun and sharing!
10. Bring a friend to the meeting who you think might enjoy the Show and tell them to bring their favorite Model and \$5 to enter into the Tabletop Show. www.esraaca.org.
